General Duties:

- Support asphalt/track crew at work sites to spread, smooth and level concrete or asphalt projects with basic work such as sweeping, shoveling, raking, tamping, cleaning, etc.
- Control traffic and deal with the public in a positive, respectful manner as required.
- Perform daily safety and maintenance checks on equipment as scheduled and/or required. Report all related problems to management.
- Ensure heavy equipment is safely and securely stored at all times.

General Requirements:

- Minimum 3 years related AZ driving experience with an outstanding driving record required.
- Demonstrated ability to safely and responsibly operate single axel, tandem axel and tri axle trucks in a safe and responsible manner; experience pulling a float is required.
- A valid AZ drivers' license with a clean drivers' abstract required.
- Strong client service and public interaction skills required.
- Previous experience in a general construction environment required.
- Experience in a variety of vehicles/equipment is an asset.
- Willing and able to work outdoors in extreme weather conditions.
- Ability to perform physically demanding work, including lifting 50 lbs. repeatedly.
